A REPORT ON INDUCTION PROGRAMME

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ABOUT INDUCTION PROGRAMME

The Induction Programme is designed to acquaint new students with the environment, working tactics & methodologies of the Institute. The programme is an endeavour to make new entrants comfortable and contented with the ethos of the organization. It provides an open approach for the students to adopt the environment, to build a bonding between faculty and students and develop cognizance, compassion and understanding of the self, people around them, society and the nature.

A five days Induction programme was organized in Shree. L. R. Tiwari College of Engineering. The programme began on 7th August 2019. Various activities and events were conducted with the aim to familiarize the students with the Institute and its environment. The main events of the Induction program were: orientation, mentoring, lectures by eminent speakers on Universal Human Values, Motivational Talks & proficiency modules. Besides these, Yoga sessions were also conducted for the students to make them understand the value of good physical and mental health needed to survive in this fast pacing competitive world.

ORIENTATION

The Orientation was the first episode of the programme where the entire information related to the academic plan, examination process, teaching learning methodologies and practices etc. was imparted to the new learners. Around 230 students along with their parents attended the orientation programme. The programme was inaugurated by respected Principal of the college, Dr. S Ram Reddy with the enchanting mantras of Sarasvati Vandana. Thereafter, the presentations were given by the class In-charges comprising all the required information related to the teaching learning activities and practices. The presentations spanning more one hour enlightened the students

as well as the parents about the various events /activities to be conducted during the semester.



MENTORING

Mentoring was the main highlight of the Induction Programme. This was the most significant part of the entire Induction programme because it connected the students with the faculty members of the respective branch/ department. This process of mentoring was carried out in different groups. Two teacher mentors and four senior student mentors from each department were introduced to the newly inducted students (branch wise). The main objective of

the mentoring was just to forecast the glimpse of four year journey of the degree course. The process started at 9:00 a.m. with the introduction of the mentors which continued with the mentor interaction sessions. The mentors helped the students to visualize the forthcoming scenario which they have to come across during their stay in the college. Not only this, the interaction helped them to make a shift in their approach towards education in a professional setup. After the interaction session, the diagnostic test for basic Maths, English and Computer was conducted for the beginners with the help of student mentors.

DEPARTMENT VISIT

On the same day, after the Lunch break, the students were guided to visit their respective departments accompanied by teacher mentors & student mentors. They visited the classrooms, laboratories, library, workshops, Exam Cell & Admin office. Finally they were addressed by the Heads of the Departments just to make them understand the upcoming transition which they have to undergo after completing the first year of Engineering.



YOGA SESSION

A two hour session on Yoga was conducted on third and fourth day of the Induction Programme for the new students under the guidance of Mrs. Samita



Bhandari, Asst. Prof., Department of Electronics. Being a certified yoga instructor she laid a great emphasis on the importance of healthy body and

tranquil mind in this hectic life. The students liked physical exercises, yogic postures and breathing exercises practiced during the session.

LECTURE BY EMINENT PERSONALITIES ON UNIVERSAL HUMAN VALUE

Mr. Shreyansh Mehta, an eminent speaker from Art of Living Mission was invited to conduct a lecture on Universal Human Values for first year students of the college. The main motto of the session was to foster the spirit of oneness among individuals. Since all are human beings and they must live in harmony with other human beings and nature as well. They must know their responsibility as a living entity on this planet, Earth. They should be guided morally how to lead their life in a noble way. The session was of a great importance in this regard.
