1	Background for development of vision statement	<p>Dr. Narayankhedkar (ACTE Margdarshak for NBA) quoted the vision statements of Education of eminent personalities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mahatma Gandhi Vision : Education was not for knowing how to read and write but for the all-round development in children. He strongly felt, Indian language should be the medium of instruction because education in English had made Indians 'Strangers in their own lands;. He conceptualized NAI TALIM or basic education for all the holistic development of a person's body, mind and soul.• Rabindranath Tagore He envisioned a school where a child would be free, happy and creative, and was able to explore his thoughts. According to him, teachers should be imaginative and innovative. Teachers should understand children and help them to develop their curious minds. He was of the opinion that the creative learning could be imparted within natural ambience.• Swami Vivekananda End of education is character.
2	Instructions for framing the Vision statement	<p>The Vision statement should focus on tomorrow and what the organisation want to become. The statement must contain specific keywords preferably with a global view and local focus. It should address long term goals (for the next 10 years or more).</p> <p>The Vision should be an inspirational as well aspirational and should challenge employees.</p> <p>Big picture of what an organisation want to achieve.</p>
3	Instructions for framing the Mission	<p>The Mission includes specific action to be followed to achieve the vision. Mission statement drives the organisation.</p>



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		<p>Mission statement supports the vision.</p> <p>Mission refers to everyday while vision is attained someday.</p> <p>The Mission statement is to begin with the word 'To'.</p> <p>The Vision and Mission statements published are for all stakeholders such as students, parents, institute management, employers, institute alumni etc.</p>
4	Allocation of Assignments	<p>Based on the above instructions, assignments were allocated to each group (3 faculty members per group), and discussion regarding the same was held in the meeting at 4.00 pm on the same day.</p> <p>The assignment topic was based on justification of each word stated in the vision and mission of specific reputed institutes and private organisations. The relevance of the vision and mission to be studied how they support each other.</p>
5	Discussion on Vision and Mission of different reputed institutes and organisations - 4.00 pm onwards	<p>Vision and Mission statements of IITs, NITs, Autonomous colleges, foreign universities and institutes and industries were presented by presented and critically reviewed.</p> <p>Dr. Narayankhedkar (NBA mentor) explained the process of designing the Vision and Mission of the Institute.</p> <p>It was decided that the Departmental Vision and Mission of SLRTCE should be reviewed with the help of all the stakeholders and the same will be discussed in the next session.</p>

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
